EXPECTATIONS OF THE JOB

- This is a part time position with a 2-year commitment
- Class will be 2-days a week times and days to be confirmed- Tuesdays and Wednesdays from 11:53am-1:25pm located at the CSI Jerome Center
- Class will begin approx.. August 23rd, 2023 and end May 17th, 2024.
- Take the online mandatory CSI Title IX, and FERPA Training
- Support students in ongoing success
- Utilize the CSI Machine Operator curriculum, simulators, and apps to instruct and teach students
- Take and pass a Background Check

WORKING FOR WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

- Pay \$27-30 hour, depending on experience
- Pay is for 6 hours per week which includes class time(4hrs), prep., and admin(2hrs).
- Mileage reimbursement of up to 45 miles round trip @ .63 per mile
